# Testimony of Loretta Y. in the

## DTE Advanced (Smart) Meter Opt-Out Case, U-17053

What follows are the relevant portions of the testimony Loretta Y. offered in the DTE opt-out case, <u>U-17053</u>. The judge refused to allow any of this health testimony, stating that it was impermissible because the only thing to be decided at the hearing was whether DTE's proposed radio-off smart meter opt-out fulfilled cost-of-service principles. Linda K, Cynthia E, and Leslie P, have filed an appeal with the Michigan Court of Appeals.

#### QUALIFICATIONS OF LORETTA YOSKOVICH

#### Q. What are your qualifications to testify?

A. The electricity on my house comes from Detroit Edison. My home is scheduled for Smart Meter installation in the near future.

#### DIRECT TESTIMONY OF LORETTA YOSKOVICH

#### Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?

A. To provide information that establishes that there is a need for a no-fee opt-out and the need for an analog meter option.

### Q. Why is it important that Detroit Edison provide an analog meter opt-out?

A. My daughter has been diagnosed with Electrical Hypersensitivity and is extremely sensitive to the pulsed radio signals and transients that are emitted from Smart Meters and Digital Meters. She becomes extremely ill when in a home or businesses that has this meter. My own daughter will be unable to visit me if either of these meters is installed on my home.

DTE's opt out policy should allow me to keep my analog meter without penalty so my daughter is free to visit me without harm.
